The Small Print

Gift Aid donations

- There is no minimum amount or minimum term for Gift Aid.
- Donations may be made by Standing Order, cheque, direct bank transfer or cash.
- Gift Aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which allows charities to reclaim 25 pence in the pound. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

Changes in your situation

You are responsible for informing the PCC Treasurer if your tax situation changes for any given tax year in which you have authorised the PCC to make Gift Aid claims. You can cancel your declaration at any time by notifying the Treasurer of the PCC.

Data protection

In completing and submitting the Gift Aid Declaration and/or Standing Order form, you agree that the St John Newland PCC may collect, store and use any personal information you may be providing for the purposes of administering your giving and complying with any requests for information from HMRC and for the purpose of providing you with information about our current and future programme of activities.
